HARBERTON'S FAMOUS CHRISTMAS TREE FESTIVAL

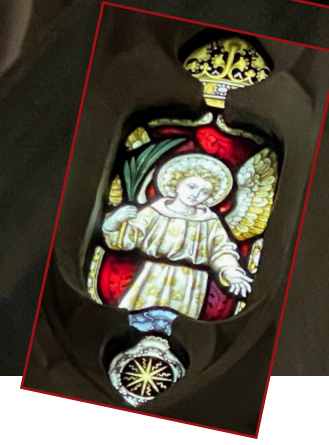
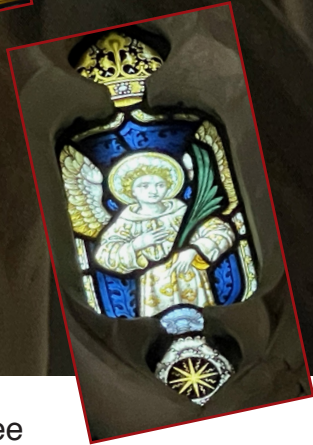
This year, look forward to Angels as well as Trees. Expect them to be as diverse as the artists' imagination!
